Dr. Resnick practices in Manhattan, NY at Evolve Health + Wellness, and serves as faculty at three US based East Asian medicine schools. The series is based on the Zheng Gu Tui Na system, a highly effective method that provides tui na training with protocols that are modular, adaptable, and immediately applicable.
