What is Title IX

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 prohibits discrimination based on sex in any educational program or activity that receives financial support from the Federal government. Under Title IX, discrimination based on sex includes sexual harassment, sexual violence and sexual assault. Title IX also prohibits retaliation against individuals who complain about or participate in an investigation regarding an alleged Title IX violation.

Individual Rights and Responsibilities

Any individual who believes she or he has been the target of any form of harassment is encouraged—but is not required—to inform the offending person verbally or in writing that such conduct is unwelcome and offensive and must stop. If the individual does not wish to communicate directly with the offending person or if such communication has not successfully put an end to the harassment, the individual is encouraged to report the unwelcome conduct as soon as possible to the Title IX Coordinator. The individual should also provide the Title IX Coordinator, with a written statement including details of the alleged harassment. The individual may request an informal mediation or a file a formal complaint. Reference Reporting Procedures Policy in your student or employee manual.
