

## Gainful Employment Disclosures – 2024- 2025 Academic Year

Program Name: Jung Tao School of Classical Chinese Medicine graduate level Diploma in Acupuncture

This program is designed to be completed in 4 years. For students with transfer credit the time to completion may be shorter.

This program will cost \$55,312 in tuition plus \$1,540 total in fees over the course of study if completed within normal time. Living expenses and books are in addition to tuition and fees expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting but are subject to change.

\$56,852 is the entire program cost of tuition and fees, assuming normal time to completion. There will be additional costs for travel, housing, and food for students not living in the region and who will commute to campus for monthly modules. The Jung Tao School does not provide room and board. Students must allocate additional funds to cover the cost of the off-campus room and board. Approximately 55-60% of Jung Tao School students take out Title IV graduate student loans. We offer annual, semester, and monthly payment plans to assist students to minimize the need for students to borrow or incur student loan debt.
